

Meter pits, meter settings, and meters shall be purchased from the department.

Upon completion of the installation, the Indian Hill Water Works shall be notified in writing and the work of installation shall be inspected by an authorized agent of the Indian Hill Water Works.

Materials and installation of the service line from the service valve to any building connections shall conform to the applicable department specifications and standards.

BACKFLOW PREVENTION

Services serving premises where a health, pollutional, or system hazard to the public system exists shall be equipped with an approved backflow prevention device. Examples of services requiring backflow prevention devices include, but are not limited to swimming pools, lawn and garden irrigation systems and fire protection systems [c.o. 52.50].

MAINTENANCE

Water service lines from the service stop into the property are the property of the owner and shall be maintained by said owner [c.o. 52.17 (E)].

LEAKS


Water leaks on the property owner's side of the service valve shall be the responsibility of the property owner and shall be corrected at the earliest practicable date. Failure to receive notification of such necessary repairs shall not relieve the property owner of the responsibility of making the necessary repairs.

FROZEN SERVICE

If a service branch is frozen between the main and the front lot line the Indian Hill Water Works shall, upon notice, cause same to be thawed without charge. That portion of the service branch between the front lot line and the house is the responsibility of the property owner and must be thawed by the property owner at the property owner's expense.

METERS

Meters shall be maintained by the department without charge to the property owner except when the meter has been damaged by freezing, hot water or other neglect on the part of the owner, in which case the cost of repair or replacement shall be the responsibility of said property owner.

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
