## REPLACEMENT OF SERVICE

If a structure served by an existing service is demolished and a new structure is constructed on the property, the service may be reused only if the service and its components are in good working order and meet current standards. If the service is upgraded to a larger service and meter size to meet current standards, the property owner shall be charged for any new components, the difference between the current cost of the original meter size and the new meter size, and the difference between the current cost of the capital improvement fee for the original meter size and the new meter size.

#### PLUMBERS CERTIFICATION

No plumber shall be permitted to place a water hydrant, make attachments to any part of the water distribution system or perform any other water supply plumbing operation, unless he/she shall have duly filed with the department, on a form to be furnished by the department a signed statement setting forth his/her name and place of business, and the name of any firm with which he/she is associated, and agreeing, on behalf of himself/herself and his/her firm, if any, that he/she, as well as such firm, shall, in the conduct of his/her water supply plumbing operations, comply with and be governed by, all and singular, all laws, ordinances, rules and regulations, penalties and conditions applicable to operations performed in connection with the Indian Hill Water Works.

### **ELECTRIC GROUND WIRES**

No electrical neutral or ground wires shall be permitted to connect to the water distribution pipes on the building side of the water meter unless the water pipes on each end of the meter are connected by means of a substantial and permanent electric jumper device.

## WATER FOR TEMPORARY USES

# PERMIT REQUIRED

The Water Works Superintendent may approve the use of Village water for construction or other temporary operations on premises not sufficiently supplied with metered water. Application shall be made to the Indian Hill Water Works department for a special permit. The permit may be granted upon such conditions as the Water Works Superintendent may determine.
