Unless otherwise specified, the Water Works Superintendent shall require that usage be measured through a meter furnished by the department the permittee shall be required to pay a deposit for the meter, an administrative fee, and associated charges for the water used based on meter rates. All charges shall be based on current ordinances.

Whenever a meter is not required, unmetered water shall be paid for on the basis of metered rates based on the estimated amount used or to be used. An administrative fee shall be charged in addition to the water used.

FIRE HYDRANT USE

All fire hydrants used for permitted purposes must have reducing coupling attached to the nozzle of the fire hydrant, with independent valve for regulating the supply. The main valve of fire hydrants must be opened full at the beginning of usage each day, and remain open until the cessation of usage each day. The water supply shall be regulated by the independent valve. The fire hydrant shall be operated only by a numbered spanner, which shall be obtained from the Indian Hill Water Works, together with a license permitting the use of such spanner. The opening or closing of a fire hydrant with other than a suitable and numbered spanner, or without special permits from Indian Hill Water Works department, shall be subject to misdemeanor charges.

In taking water from a fire hydrant for construction or street sprinkling purposes, no leakage, either from hydrant, hose, pipe, sprinkling vessel shall be tolerated.

CISTERNS

No permit shall be issued to fill any cistern from a fire hydrant or a private water service branch when such cistern is located on premises which abut a street containing a water main available for service connections.
